

Parent Teacher Group Meeting  
November 30, 2006

Kathy went over the notes from the last meeting.

The PTC portion of the Election Day pie sale was \$250. The Pizza sale was \$595 with \$95 going to the 8<sup>th</sup> Grade. Kathy noted to be sure to annotate the student with the donation because the class hadn't finalized the way to divide the fundraising. The pizza delivery went very well. Cheryl had to only deliver 3 orders.

Cheryl stated the group needs to set a goal; what do we want to bring to the school as a group. She noted there is not a lot of participation; however if we picked something specific and have a chart showing process toward the goal that more people may come forward.

We need to figure out how to get more involvement on fundraising.

Kathy stated that she thought that Jen was going to do the Penny collection in January as the Student Council is currently holding one. Kari reported that there was a lot of interest from the teachers on needed items for outdoor play.

Cheryl started the PTC to have involvement; things for younger students to do. She still wants to have a K-5 valentine/winter sock hop. Kathy stated that the Bicentennial Committee with the help of the 8<sup>th</sup> grade would be having a community sock-hop in March.

Kathy suggested Movie night; Cheryl thought the 8<sup>th</sup> grade was going to do that as a fundraiser. Kathy said it hadn't been discussed. The group decided that a movie night(s) might work. The movies could run from 5-7 PM, sell tickets for the movie playing, have different classrooms set up with G, PG, PG-13 movies and sell snacks. **Movie night idea tabled until December meeting.**

The group discussed the recent Thanksgiving feast that Nobleboro School recently had with the parents coming in and eating with the students. It was noted that the nutrition staff from the cafeteria puts that on. Someone suggested doing a Grandparents breakfast.

Cheryl asked if the school holds a celebration for the 100<sup>th</sup> day of school. The group discussed that this could tie into a winter carnival type event with daily events for the week i.e. hat day; pj day; school spirit; inside/out; crazy hair; twin day; etc and finish up with a K-5 dance. Have the teachers keep a tally with class participation and hold a food type party for the class with the most percent participating. Purchase prizes from Oriental Trader or host an ice cream social.

We discussed having teachers present at PTC meetings, noting that a lot live far away and like to get home within reasonable times. Mrs. Turner stated she would be supportive.

The group discussed holding the meetings promptly from 6-7 PM so people who wanted to attend knew it would be 1 hour only, may have more participation. The group agreed to hold the meetings the 3<sup>rd</sup> Thursday of the month. This would allow time to add an item to the agenda at a School Board Committee meeting which are held the 1<sup>st</sup> Wednesday of every month.

Cheryl stated she would like to see a bicentennial float this year. Christy stated she would check with her husband about the possibility of using the flatbed for a float.

The group also discussed daycare options for people with kids that wanted to attend, but not leave kids at home. Possibly getting the word out that if they need childcare to call and we would have a babysitter present.

Christy stated that Waldoboro has a Bus Driver appreciation day. We could even do a teacher appreciation day.

Cheryl stated she found a spring catalog for fundraising and will bring it in.

The mission currently is getting PTC name out there to the community.
